Aurora, the light of Seville

Metropol Parasol

Metropol Parasol popularly known as *Las Setas* (the mushrooms) is the largest wooden structure in the world, designed by architect Jürgen Meyer in the Plaza de la Encarnación. It houses a traditional market, restaurants, the Antiquarium archaeological museum and it's crowned with a viewpoint over the old town. Every night it offers *Aurora*, a light show that lights up Seville.

Candlelight Concerts

Check out the music program

Seville is dressed in the colours of autumn and an exquisite selection of concerts in dream locations filled with hundreds of candles. Enjoy Candlelight with music by The Beatles, Queen, Hans Zimmer, Tchaikovsky, ABBA or Coldplay vs Imagine Dragons.

Thursday Market

Feria Street

It's a famous outdoor market for being the oldest one in Spain. This market takes places every Thursday from centuries ago. The origin is unknown, although it's thought it started before the conquest of Seville by King Fernando III from Castilla. Nowadays, it's an antiques and second-hand market.

Antique and Second-hand Book Fair

Until 20th October in the Plaza Nueva

This Fair will bring together the country's most important antiquarian bookshops. Unique, out-of-print or hard-to-find books, film posters, posters, manuscripts and other collectors' publications.

Creative Crafts Fair

Until 20th October in the Av. de la Constitución

More than thirty workshops will feed the autumn spirit in their stalls next to the Cathedral. Under the slogan 'Made in Seville', this is the third edition of the fair, which has consolidated its position as one of the city's benchmarks for the sector. You will be able to buy local pieces of all kinds, from pottery, ceramics, leather, jewellery, wrought iron and textiles.

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Palacio de Dueñas

Historic Palace House guided tour

This is one of the 25 Palace Houses of Seville. Built in the 15th century, it was property of the Duchy of Alba since the 17th century, the residence of the Spanish poet Antonio Machado and witness to illustrious guests of the Dukes of Alba such as Jacqueline Kennedy, Grace Kelly or Rainier of Monaco. Discover the palace, patios and gardens.



Sevilla by night

Guided night-time tour

Stroll through the centre of Seville and discover the events that shook its inhabitants. Learn a little more about the Santa Cruz district great history. A guide will tell you about the events of Roman, Arab, Jew and Christian cultures and some mysteries and ghosts. 15 stops plus an interpretation of the history of Seville.

Córdoba

Day trip

Córdoba -the city of the flowers- is known worldwide for its Mosque-Cathedral. The city also has a beautiful Roman bridge and a monumental old town declared World Heritage site, with small streets, flowered patios and pleasant squares.
