### Don Juan Tenorio

#### Until December 10th

There is a long-standing tradition in Seville that links All Saints' Day with "Don Juan Tenorio" (Don Giovanni). Consolidated for years, the popular dramatised visits *Don Juan Tenorio in the San Fernando Cemetery* have brought together more than 30,000 people.

### Guitar Festival

#### Until to November 17th

The city celebrates the Guitar Festival 15th edition with concerts and galas that will take place at "Espacio Turina" as well as emblematic venues such as Real Alcázar, Sala Antiquerium or Casa de los Pinelo. This year's edition is dedicated to the Sevillian poet Antonio Machado in his eighty-fifth death anniversary.

### Nativity Fair

#### Until December 23rd

Organised by the Association of Nativity Scene Vendors and the City Council, this fair takes place around the Cathedral and the Archive of the Indies, between Fray Ceferino González Street and Constitución Avenue. On the occasion of the 800th anniversary of the first nativity scene built in the city by Saint Francis of Assisi, the Nativity Scene Fair is entitled *Franciscus 1223–2024*.

### Candlelight Concerts

#### Check out the music program

Seville offers an exquisite selection of concerts in dream locations filled with hundreds of candles. Enjoy Candlelight with music by Hans Zimmer, Tchaikovsky, Vivaldi, ABBA or Coldplay.

### Thursday Market

#### Feria Street

It's a famous outdoor market for being the oldest one in Spain. This market takes places every Thursday from centuries ago. The origin is unknown, although it's thought it started before the conquest of Sevilla by King Fernando III from Castilla. Nowadays, it's an antiques and second-hand market.

### Palacio de Dueñas

Historic Palace House guided tour

This is one of the 25 Palace Houses of Seville. Built in the 15th century, it was property of the Duchy of Alba since the 17th century, the residence of the Spanish poet Antonio Machado and witness to illustrious guests of the Dukes of Alba such as Jacqueline Kennedy, Grace Kelly or Rainier of Monaco. Discover the palace, patios and gardens.





## Sevilla by night

Guided night-time tour

Stroll through the centre of Seville and discover the events that shook its inhabitants. Learn a little more about the Santa Cruz district great history. A guide will tell you about the events of Roman, Arab, Jew and Christian cultures and some mysteries and ghosts. 15 stops plus an interpretation of the history of Seville.

### Córdoba Day trip

Córdoba -the city of the flowers- is known worldwide for its Mosque-Cathedral. The city also has a beautiful Roman bridge and a monumental old town declared World Heritage site, with small streets, flowered patios and pleasant squares.
