Don Juan Tenorio

Until December 10th

There is a long-standing tradition in Seville that links All Saints' Day with "Don Juan Tenorio" (Don Giovanni). Consolidated for years, the popular dramatised visits *Don Juan Tenorio* in the *San Fernando Cemetery* have brought together more than 30,000 people.

Christmas Lights

Tour in the City Center

During the Festive season, more than 200 streets and squares are decorated with lights and figures, especially on Avenida de la Constitución, Sierpes and Tetuán Streets. It's the perfect plan to stroll through the center, take photos and enjoy the Christmas atmosphere.

Nativity Fair

Until December 23rd

Organised by the Association of Nativity Scene Vendors and the City Council, this fair takes place around the Cathedral and the Archive of the Indies, between Fray Ceferino González Street and Constitución Avenue.

On the occasion of the 800th anniversary of the first nativity scene built in the city by Saint Francis of Assisi, the Nativity Scene Fair is entitled *Franciscus 1223-2024*.

Candlelight Concerts

Check out the music program

Seville offers an exquisite selection of concerts in dream locations filled with hundreds of candles. Enjoy Candlelight with magical soundtracks and classic Christmas pieces or Tchaikovsky works, such as *The Nutcracker*.

Mapping Show

From December 20th to January 4th

Seville presents an impressive light and projection show on the Guadalquivir River dock. It can be seen from the Muelle de la Sal, opposite the Triana river side. Projections have spectacular visual effects, ideal for all ages.

Casa de Pilatos

Guided visit to a historical palace

This 16th-century Sevillian palace combines Mudejar and Renaissance styles, with superb courtyards, gardens, and classic sculptures. Highlights include its main courtyard and art collection. Located at Plaza de Pilatos, it's a perfect visit to explore Seville's noble architecture.
